Dark morning dress or uniform with Royal Arch and Festival Jewels to be worn.

Advice for the Annual Provincial Grand lodge Meeting

Brethren, you may have already received the Summons for the Annual Provincial Grand Lodge Meeting, to be held at the Stafford Showground on Tuesday 21st June 2022, commencing at 4.30pm.

This meeting is open to all brethren who are Master Masons and above and it is hoped that ALL Lodges within the Province of Staffordshire are represented.

If you are attending the meeting, there are a number of important briefing matters that you should be aware of, as follows:

- There will not be a separate briefing for Appointed and Promoted Officers, as in previous years.
- Please arrive at the Venue in good time to be seated by 4.00pm prompt.
- Worshipful Masters and Lodge Wardens should wear their Lodge Collars of Office.
- Newly Appointed Active Provincial Officer are to collect their respective Collar Jewels, on arrival, in the Reception Foyer from the Provincial Assistant Grand Secretary, therefore please arrive in good time to receive them and attach it to your Collar before the commencement of the Meeting.
- Newly Appointed and Promoted Officers will have a designated seat in the Temple, therefore please arrive in good time to locate it.
- There will be a briefing from the Stage by the Provincial Grand Director of Ceremonies at 4.15pm.
- When the Appointment & Investiture of Officers item of the Agenda takes place, if
 you are the recipient of an Active Provincial Office OR a First Appointment to a Past
 Provincial Rank, you are required to REMOVE your Collar before being presented to the
 RWPGM for Investiture.
- If you are being Promoted to a Past Provincial Rank, you are required to wear your collar when being presented to the RWPGM, who will congratulate you and shake your hand.
- The Breast Jewels to be worn, Royal Arch Jewels, 2024 Festival Jewels (if appropriate) OR Tercentenary Jewel are to be worn. No other Breast Jewels are to be worn i.e. Founder's Jewels, Past Master's Jewels or Jewels of other Masonic Orders.
- At the close of the PGL Meeting, Active Provincial Officers are to return to the Temple for a Provincial Photograph to be taken.
- Please be reminded that all Mobile Phones should at least be in 'Silent' mode, however, preferably SWITCHED OFF.

I hope this advice is helpful to all brethren who are attending and I hope you all have an enjoyable meeting.

Like all Freemasonry it is 'free' but there is a subscription of £25 a year which pays for the music and makes a contribution towards the conductor's costs.


We would love to welcome you to the choir.
